Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsections (c-2), (c-3), and (d) and amending Subsection 7 8 (g) to read as follows: 9 (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2017-2018 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time 10 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 11 12 nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the 13 sum of: 14 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have received for the 2017-2018 school year under the district's salary 15 schedule for the 2016-2017 school year, if that schedule had been in 16 effect for the 2017-2018 school year, including any local 17 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement 18 the employee would have received in the 2017-2018 school year; and 19 (2) \$100. 20 21 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September <u>1, 2018.</u> 22 23 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 24

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nurse employed by a school district in the 2017-2018 school year is, 1 as long as the employee is employed by the same district, entitled 2 to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the employee 3 received for the 2017-2018 school year. 4 5 The commissioner may adopt rules to (q) govern the application of this section, including rules that: 6 7 require the payment of a minimum salary under this (1)8 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those 9 10 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and specify the credentials a person must hold to be 11 (2) considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this 12 13 section. SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended 14 15 to read as follows: 16 A school district, including a school district that is (a) otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled 17 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of: 18 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of 19 full-time district employees, other than administrators 20 or employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section 21 21.402; [and] 22 the product of \$1,000 multiplied by the number of 23 (2) 24 classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time school counselors certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time 25 26 school nurses employed by the district; and (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of 27

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1 part-time district employees, other than administrators.

2 SECTION 3. Subject to Section 5(b) of this Act, the amount 3 of \$1 billion is appropriated from the economic stabilization fund 4 to the foundation school fund for distribution by the commissioner 5 of education during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 6 1, 2017, to school districts to provide salary increases as 7 provided by Section 42.2513, Education Code, as amended by this 8 Act.

9 SECTION 4. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is 10 repealed.

11 SECTION 5. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section:

(1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and

(2) if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
last day of the legislative session.

(b) Section 3 of this Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature, as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.

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
