| 10 | (1) a kindergarten through grade 12 program whose |
| 11 | preceding or current year's average daily attendance is less than |
| 12 | 130 students shall be provided an adjusted basic allotment on the |
| 13 | basis of 130 students in average daily attendance; |
| 14 | (2) a kindergarten through grade 8 program whose |
| 15 | preceding or current year's average daily attendance is less than |
| 16 | 75 students shall be provided an adjusted basic allotment on the |
| 17 | basis of 75 students in average daily attendance; and |
| 18 | (3) a kindergarten through grade 6 program whose |
| 19 | preceding or current year's average daily attendance is less than |
| 20 | 60 students shall be provided an adjusted basic allotment on the |
| 21 | basis of 60 students in average daily attendance. |
| 22 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017, if it |
| 23 | receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each |
| 24 | house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. |
