| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by |
| 6 | adding Subsections (c-2), (c-3), and (d) and amending Subsection |
| 7 | (g) to read as follows: |
| 8 | (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2017-2018 |
| 9 | school year, a classroom teacher is entitled to a monthly salary |
| 10 | that is at least equal to the sum of: |
| 11 | (1) the monthly salary the teacher would have received |
| 12 | for the 2017-2018 school year under the district's salary schedule |
| 13 | for the 2016-2017 school year, if that schedule had been in effect |
| 14 | for the 2017-2018 school year, including any local supplement and |
| 15 | any money representing a career ladder supplement the teacher would |

- 18 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September

- 20 (d) A classroom teacher employed by a school district in the
- 21 2017-2018 school year is, as long as the teacher is employed by the
- 22 same district, entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the
- 23 salary the teacher received for the 2017-2018 school year.

24 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the

- 2 (1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this
- 3 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a

- 6 (2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be

- 9 SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 12 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 13 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 14 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of
- 15 full-time district employees, other than administrators or
- 16 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 17 21.402; [and]
- 18 (2) the product of \$1,000 multiplied by the number of
- 19 classroom teachers employed by the district; and
- 20 (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 21 part-time district employees, other than administrators.
- SECTION 3. The amount of \$1 billion is appropriated from the
- 23 economic stabilization fund to the foundation school fund for
- 24 distribution by the commissioner of education during the state
- 25 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2017, to school districts to
- 26 provide classroom teacher salary increases as provided by Section
- 27 42.2513, Education Code, as amended by this Act.

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- 1 SECTION 4. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is 2 repealed.
- 3 SECTION 5. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section:
- 4 (1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a
- 5 vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
- 7 (2) if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 8 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 9 last day of the legislative session.
- 10 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of
- 11 two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature,
- 12 as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.
