BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 411.952 to read as follows: 8 9 Sec. 411.952. INVESTIGATION AND REPORT ON SEXUAL ASSAULT AT POSTSECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS. (a) In this section, 10 "postsecondary education<u>al institution" means an institution of</u> 11 12 higher education or a private or independent institution of higher education, as those terms are defined by Section 61.003, Education 13 14 Code. (b) Using funds already appropriated, the Department of 15 16 Public Safety shall collect information regarding the response by public institutions of higher education, and private institutions 17 of higher education that receive tuition equalization grants, to 18 reports of sexual assault committed against students enrolled at 19 those institutions. The investigation must include a review of 20 policies adopted by those institutions that have the effect of 21 deterring students from reporting incidents of sexual assault or of 22 23 hindering investigations of those reports. (c) Not later than December 1, 2018, the department shall 24

2 <u>Coordinating Board a report on the department's findings. Based on</u>
3 <u>the department's report, the coordinating board shall review the</u>
4 <u>policies adopted by those institutions that have the effect of</u>
5 <u>deterring students from reporting those incidents or of hindering</u>
6 <u>investigations of those reports.</u>
7 <u>(d) This section expires September 1, 2019.</u>

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 13 legislative session.
