13	established under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code.
14	(b) The commission, in coordination with the task force,
15	shall develop for and provide to each pregnant woman enrolled in
16	Medicaid or the CHIP perinatal program informational materials to
17	increase the woman's ability to advocate for herself on
18	reproductive health issues to her health care provider. The
19	informational materials must include information on the possible
20	health risks and complications a woman may incur before the first
21	anniversary of the date the woman gave birth or her pregnancy ended.
22	(c) The informational materials developed under Subsection
23	(b) may be in a paper or easily accessible electronic format or in
24	another format the commission determines appropriate for the
