A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the salary paid to classroom teachers employed by
3	public schools; making an appropriation.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (c-2), (c-3), (c-4), and (d) and amending
7	Subsection (g) to read as follows:
8	(c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2017-2018
9	school year, a classroom teacher is entitled to a monthly salary
10	that is at least equal to the sum of:
11	(1) the monthly salary the teacher would have received
12	for the 2017-2018 school year under the district's salary schedule
13	for the 2016-2017 school year, if that schedule had been in effect

- 14 for the 2017-2018 school year, including any local supplement and
- 15 any money representing a career ladder supplement the teacher would
- 16 have received in the 2017-2018 school year; and
- 17 (2) the amount determined by the commissioner under
- 18 Subsection (c-3), not to exceed \$100.
- 19 <u>(c-3) The commissioner, in collaboration with</u>
- 20 representatives from school districts and using publicly available
- 21 data, shall determine a cost-of-living adjustment for classroom
- 22 <u>teacher salaries based on any change in the average cost of living</u>
- 23 since the most recent state-funded pay raise for classroom
- 24 teachers.

- 1 (c-4) Subsections (c-2), (c-3), and this subsection expire
- 2 September 1, 2018.
- 3 (d) A classroom teacher employed by a school district in the
- 4 2017-2018 school year is, as long as the teacher is employed by the
- 5 same district, entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the
- 6 salary the teacher received for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 7 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the
- 8 application of this section, including rules that:
- 9 (1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this
- 10 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a
- 11 minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those
- 12 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and
- 13 (2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be
- 14 considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this
- 15 section.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 19 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 20 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 21 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of
- 22 full-time district employees, other than administrators or
- 23 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 24 21.402; [and]
- 25 (2) the product of the annual raise provided as a
- 26 result of Section 21.402(c-2), as added by ___.B. ____, Acts of the
- 27 85th Legislature, 1st Called Session, 2017, multiplied by the

1 number of classroom teachers employed by the district; and

- 2 (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 3 part-time district employees, other than administrators.
- 4 SECTION 3. The amount of \$1 billion is appropriated from the
- 5 economic stabilization fund to the foundation school fund for
- 6 distribution by the commissioner of education during the state
- 7 fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2017, to school districts to
- 8 provide classroom teacher salary increases as provided by Section
- 9 42.2513, Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is
- 11 repealed.
- 12 SECTION 5. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section:
- 13 (1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a
- 14 vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
- 16 (2) if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 17 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 18 last day of the legislative session.
- 19 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of
- 20 two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature,
- 21 as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.
