A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of maternal health access zones. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Health and Safety Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Subchapter E to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER E. MATERNAL HEALTH ACCESS ZONES Sec. 32.101. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 7 (1) "Maternal health access zone" means a contiguous 8 9 geographic area of this state that has measurable and documented health disparities and poor health outcomes and that is designated 10 by the department as a maternal health access zone under this 11 12 subchapter. (2) "Task force" means the Maternal Mortality and 13 14 Morbidity Task Force established under Chapter 34. Sec. 32.102. ESTABLISHMENT OF MATERNAL HEALTH ACCESS ZONES. 15 16 The department, in conjunction with the commission and the task force, shall establish maternal health access zones in areas of 17 this state that are medically underserved or have health 18 19 disparities among socioeconomic, racial, ethnic, and geographic populations to increase access to maternal health care and reduce 20 the maternal mortality and morbidity rates in those areas. 21 Sec. 32.103. ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING. The department, in 22 23 conjunction with the commission and task force, shall select at least one health care facility or nonprofit entity as a health care 24

1	provider for each designated maternal health access zone. The
2	facility or entity is eligible to receive funds for programs
3	determined by the department to reduce health disparities and
4	health care costs and improve health outcomes for women residing in
5	the zone who are or who have recently been pregnant.
6	Sec. 32.104. RULES. The executive commissioner by rule
7	shall establish the eligibility requirements, an application
8	process, and any other rules necessary to implement this
9	subchapter. The application process must require each applicant to
10	submit a sustainable plan to reduce health disparities and health
11	care costs and improve health outcomes for women residing in the
12	zone.
13	Sec. 32.105. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The department may accept
14	gifts and grants from any source for the purposes of this
15	subchapter.
16	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect December 1, 2017.
