- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 41, Education Code, is 10 amended by adding Section 41.0941 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 41.0941. ATTENDANCE CREDIT RECEIPTS FUND. (a) The
- 12 attendance credit receipts fund is created as a fund in the state
- 13 treasury, administered by the comptroller.
- 14 (b) The attendance credit receipts fund shall consist of
- 15 payments made by school districts under Section 41.094 for the
- 16 purchase of attendance credits under this subchapter.
- (c) Money deposited to the attendance credit receipts fund
- 18 may only be used for foundation school program purposes.
- 19 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 20 of this Act, the comptroller shall transfer from the general
- 21 revenue fund to the attendance credit receipts fund created under
- 22 Section 41.0941, Education Code, as added by this Act, any funds
