A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment regarding the limitation on
- 2 the rate of growth of appropriations.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 22(a) and (b), Article VIII, Texas
- 5 Constitution, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The rate of growth of appropriations from all sources of
- 7 state revenue other than the federal government for each category
- 8 of state spending identified by this subsection may not in any [In
- 9 no] biennium exceed the estimated [shall the] rate of growth in the
- 10 population served by expenditures in that spending category,
- 11 adjusted by the estimated rate of inflation in a representative set
- 12 of goods and services for which appropriations are made for that
- 13 spending category. The categories of state spending to which this
- 14 subsection applies are transportation, public primary and
- 15 secondary education, higher education, health care, public safety
- 16 and corrections, and other general government [of appropriations
- 17 from state tax revenues not dedicated by this constitution exceed
- 18 the estimated rate of growth of the state's economy]. The
- 19 legislature by general law may define each category of state
- 20 spending to which this subsection applies and shall provide [by
- 21 general law] procedures to implement this subsection.
- 22 (b) If the legislature by adoption of a resolution approved
- 23 by a record vote of a majority of the members of each house finds
- 24 that an emergency exists and identifies the nature of the

- 1 emergency, the legislature may provide for appropriations in excess
- 2 of the amount authorized by Subsection (a) of this section for a
- 3 category of state spending. The excess amount authorized under
- 4 this subsection may not exceed the amount specified in the
- 5 resolution for the category of state spending.
- 6 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 7 the Texas Constitution:
- 8 <u>TEMPORARY PROVISION</u>. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 9 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th Legislature,
- 10 1st Called Session, 2017, regarding the limitation on the rate of
- 11 growth of appropriations.
- (b) The amendments to Section 22, Article VIII, of this
- 13 constitution apply only in relation to appropriations made for the
- 14 state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2019, and subsequent
- 15 <u>state fiscal bienniums.</u>
- (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2020.
- 17 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment regarding the
- 21 limitation on the rate of growth of appropriations."
