A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the appropriation
- 2 or distribution of state money for the performance of an elective
- 3 abortion or to a person or entity that performs or assists in
- 4 performing an elective abortion.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 7. (a) This state may not appropriate any money to an
- 9 agency or political subdivision of this state to be expended for the
- 10 performance of an elective abortion.
- 11 (b) To the extent allowed by federal law, money appropriated
- 12 by this state to an agency or political subdivision of this state
- 13 may not be distributed to a person or entity that performs or
- 14 assists in performing an elective abortion during the period for
- 15 which the money is appropriated.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2018.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the
- 20 appropriation or distribution of state money for the performance of
- 21 an elective abortion or to a person or entity that performs or
- 22 assists in performing an elective abortion."
