A JOINT RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
is amended by adding Subsection (q) to read as follows:

9 (q) The legislature by general law may provide that for a temporary period following a natural disaster the total amount of 10 ad valorem taxes imposed on a residence homestead by a political 11 subdivision may not exceed the amount of taxes the political 12 subdivision imposed on the property in the year in which the 13 14 property was rendered uninhabitable or unusable as a result of the The legislature by general law may prescribe 15 disaster. 16 requirements for eligibility for a tax limitation authorized by this subsection and procedures for the administration of this 17 subsection. 18

19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017. 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the 23 legislature to limit for a temporary period the total amount of ad 24 valorem taxes that may be imposed by a political subdivision on a
