1 WHEREAS, A rich and purposeful life drew to a close with the
2 passing of John Benton Love of Mount Vernon on June 30, 2017, at the
3 age of 69; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Glen Allan, Mississippi, John Love was
5 born on September 10, 1947, to Robert and Lillian Love; after
6 graduating from Greenville High School, he continued his education
7 and ultimately earned his Ph.D. in educational psychology from
8 Mississippi State University; he also answered his nation's call to
9 duty by serving in the Mississippi Army National Guard; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Love enjoyed a rewarding career in education
11 that included positions as an art teacher, coach, and principal at
12 the secondary level in Mississippi; after relocating to Tyler, he
13 spent more than a decade as a principal at Douglas and Andy Woods
14 Elementary Schools before becoming director of the Discovery
15 Science Place, where he oversaw the museum's creation and is
16 credited with building a number of the exhibits that remain on
17 display there; he later returned to academia and taught at
18 Southeastern Oklahoma State University and Jarvis Christian
19 College; in recent years, he dedicated himself to developing his
20 craft as an artist; and

21 WHEREAS, Committed to his local community, Dr. Love shared
22 his time and talents with the Franklin County Historical
23 Association and the Franklin County Arts Alliance; and

24 WHEREAS, Although he will be greatly missed, John Love made a

1 profound impact on countless young people through his contributions
2 as an educator, and all those who had the privilege of knowing him
3 will forever hold him close in their hearts; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
5 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory
6 of John Benton Love and extend heartfelt sympathy to the members of
7 his family: to his beloved Sandra Love; to his children,

9 Alison, Harper, August, Quentin, Morgan, and Niu Niu; and, be it
