WHEREAS, Dr. Love enjoyed a rewarding career in education 10 11 that included positions as an art teacher, coach, and principal at 12 the secondary level in Mississippi; after relocating to Tyler, he spent more than a decade as a principal at Douglas and Andy Woods 13 14 Elementary Schools before becoming director of the Discovery Science Place, where he oversaw the museum's creation and is 15 credited with building a number of the exhibits that remain on 16 display there; he later returned to academia and taught at 17 18 Southeastern Oklahoma State University and Jarvis Christian College; in recent years, he dedicated himself to developing his 19 20 craft as an artist; and

21 WHEREAS, Committed to his local community, Dr. Love shared 22 his time and talents with the Franklin County Historical 23 Association and the Franklin County Arts Alliance; and
