19 WHEREAS, Because widespread immunizations limit the spread 20 of disease among those who are too young or who are otherwise unable 21 to receive vaccinations, a low rate of immunization has the 22 troubling potential to endanger especially the more vulnerable 23 members of society, and it creates a greater risk of disease 24 outbreak; and
