R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Three schools from the Brazosport Independent
2 School District earned a top rating from the Texas Education Agency
3 as a result of student performance on the State of Texas Assessments
4 of Academic Readiness tests administered in 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, To ensure that all students in Texas benefit from
6 the highest standards of education, TEA instituted a new
7 accountability rating system for the state's public schools and
8 districts in 2013; for a campus to gain "met standard"
9 classification, it must reach the target requirements in categories
10 that include student achievement, student progress, closing
11 performance gaps, and postsecondary readiness; and

12 WHEREAS, The Brazosport ISD campuses that attained this
13 distinction include O. A. Fleming Elementary School, Jane Long
14 Elementary School, and R. O'Hara Lanier Middle School; their
15 success comes as part of a districtwide effort to implement
16 turnaround initiatives of data analysis, needs assessments, and
17 improvement planning; and

18 WHEREAS, The educators and young people at these schools have
19 demonstrated outstanding dedication and perseverance in their
20 pursuit of academic excellence, and they may indeed take
21 justifiable pride in this prestigious designation from the State of
