WHEREAS, Family and friends will forever treasure their
memories of Silvina Solis Hinojosa of La Grulla, who died on May 15,
2017, at the age of 92; and

WHEREAS, Silvina Solis was born in La Grulla on December 8, 4 5 1924, to Juan and Dolores Solis, and she graduated from Rio Grande City High School in 1942; she was joined in matrimony to Isidro 6 7 Hinojosa, and the couple became the devoted parents of five children, Isidro, Alma, Ricardo, Linda, and Jose; later in life, 8 9 she was blessed with eight grandchildren and five 10 great-grandchildren; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hinojosa aspired to become a teacher from a 12 young age and earned both her bachelor's and master's degrees in 13 education from The University of Texas--Pan American; she taught 14 for the La Joya Independent School District for 28 years, during 15 which time she was named the 1972 Teacher of the Year, and then 16 spent another 10 years as an administrator; and

WHEREAS, Over the course of her career, Mrs. Hinojosa headed 17 18 the remedial reading department, coached University Interscholastic League teams, organized the district's first 19 junior high school student council, directed the ESAA program, and 20 21 led the GED program; after retiring in 1985, she returned to serve both La Joya ISD and Hidalgo ISD as a parental involvement 22 consultant; she also served on the Rio Grande City Consolidated ISD 23 school board from 1998 to 2011, and during her tenure she was 24

WHEREAS, A woman of strong religious faith, Mrs. Hinojosa 3 donated land in La Victoria for the construction of Christo Rey 4 5 Catholic Church, and she was active in the life of Holy Family Catholic Church in La Grulla, where she served for a number of years 6 on the parish council; deeply engaged in her community, she also 7 8 advised the USDA Farm Service Agency of Starr County and served on the boards of the Starr County appraisal district and hospital 9 10 district; while leading the latter board as president, she oversaw the introduction of ambulance service in rural areas and the 11 establishment of a school to train licensed vocational nurses; and 12

WHEREAS, A devoted wife, a loving mother and grandmother, and an inspiring educator, Silvina Hinojosa lived a rich and purposeful life, and her example of service to others will continue to inspire all those who knew and loved her; now, therefore, be it
