2 too soon with the passing of James Edward Vasek of Austin on May 29,
3 2017, at the age of 48; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on December 30, 1968, in Spokane, Washington,
5 Jim Vasek was the son of Edward James Vasek Jr. and Mary Manno
6 Vasek; he graduated as valedictorian of his class at La Grange High
7 School and went on to receive his bachelor's degree in physics from
8 Rice University before earning two master's degrees in physics and
9 material science from the University of Wisconsin--Madison; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Vasek built a successful 23-year career in
11 engineering with tenures at Motorola, Freescale Semiconductor, and
12 NXP Semiconductors; along the way, he maintained an active
13 lifestyle, which included mountain biking and completing many
14 marathons, half-marathons, and triathlons; in his free time, he
15 also enjoyed astronomy and volunteered extensively with Texas 4000
16 for Cancer, Head for the Cure, Sunshine Camps of Austin, and Rice
17 Engineering Alumni; and

18 WHEREAS, Devoted to his family, Mr. Vasek cherished his wife
19 of 21 years, Heather, and their children, Jenna and Dylan; he was
20 known for going out of his way to make others smile, and he enjoyed
21 planning parties and celebrating the achievements of those around
22 him; in turn, he was comforted by the support of his loved ones and
23 colleagues while fighting a long and courageous battle with cancer,
24 and he inspired them with the optimism, good humor, and spirit that

1 he demonstrated during that trying time; and

2 WHEREAS, A man of impressive intellect and boundless zest for
3 life, Jim Vasek will be greatly missed, and he will forever be
4 remembered with deepest affection and admiration by those who held
5 him dear; now, therefore, be it

7 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory
8 of James Edward Vasek and extend heartfelt condolences to all who
