WHEREAS, A native of Edinburg, Joe Rodriguez earned his bachelor's degree at Pan American College, where he also played basketball and baseball, and he later received a master's degree from Sam Houston State University; he began his career as an assistant coach at Brownsville High School in the late 1950s and worked his way up to athletic director, a post he held from 1991 to 2009; and

WHEREAS, Early in his career, Mr. Rodriguez coached the 11 12 Brownsville High baseball team to a state championship appearance in 1965, and he took the Golden Eagles football team to the 13 14 regionals in the 1969 state playoffs; moreover, he was instrumental in raising college scholarship funds for nearly 1,000 Brownsville 15 students, and as athletic director, he oversaw the upgrade of BISD 16 athletic facilities to include all-weather tracks and soccer fields 17 with lights at each high school campus, as well as the opening of 18 the Margaret M. Clark Aquatic Center and the renovation of Sams 19 20 Memorial Stadium; and

21 WHEREAS, This notable Texan has further given of his time and 22 talents as secretary of the Brownsville ISD Board of Trustees, to 23 which he was reelected in 2014 after first serving that body for 15 24 years in the 1970s and 1980s; his myriad contributions have been
