1 WHEREAS, Jamie Sullins is concluding her distinguished
2 tenure on the board of the Arlington Independent School District in
3 2017; and

4 WHEREAS, First elected in 2010, Ms. Sullins most recently
5 served as president of the board, which was named both the 2014
6 Outstanding School Board of Texas by the Texas Association of
7 School Administrators and the 2015 Outstanding School Board by the
8 H-E-B Excellence in Education Awards program; the board developed a
9 clear vision for the district in its rigorous strategic planning
10 process, an approach that has enabled strong governance through
11 transformation while fostering a culture of respect and
12 transparency; and

13 WHEREAS, From 2015 to 2017, Ms. Sullins also served on the
14 board of the Council of the Great City Schools; she is the founder
15 and former president of the North Arlington Education Alliance,
16 which works closely with the district to promote academic
17 excellence; in addition, she has given generously of her time and
18 expertise as a member of the advisory boards of the Salvation Army
19 of Arlington, Junior League of Arlington, and Arlington Chamber of
20 Commerce; and

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Sullins has brought to her role on the school
22 board extensive experience in the realm of finance; she was
23 employed at Interturbine Group of Companies as manager of financial
24 planning and analysis in its global operations, and she also worked

1 for Lockheed Martin Missiles and Advanced Programs; a graduate of
2 Texas Tech University, she holds a bachelor's degree of business
3 administration in finance; in all her endeavors, she is supported
4 by the love and encouragement of her husband, Gerald; they are the
5 proud parents of two AISD graduates, Ryan and Amanda; and

6 WHEREAS, Through her leadership and deep commitment to public
7 education, Jamie Sullins has greatly benefited the community, and
8 she may reflect with pride on her contributions to the local school
9 system; now, therefore, be it
