1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow caused by 2 the loss of United States Marine Corps Staff Sergeant Joshua 3 Michael Snowden of Dallas, who died while serving his country on 4 July 10, 2017, at the age of 31; and

5 WHEREAS, The son of Gay Hayslett and Michael Snowden, Josh Snowden, who was also known as "Snow" by his many friends, was born 6 7 in Abilene on July 22, 1985; he grew up in the Dallas area and played lacrosse as a student at Highland Park High School; following 8 graduation in 2004, he decided to defer college for a while and 9 enlisted in the United States Marine Corps Reserve; he subsequently 10 11 continued his education at Texas State University, where he played 12 on the men's lacrosse team; and

WHEREAS, After completing his bachelor's degree in 2010, 13 14 Staff Sergeant Snowden embarked on a career in the military; he was called to active duty in July 2012 and became a flight instructor 15 16 and engineer for KC-130T model planes; deployed twice to Iraq, he earned 16 medals and awards, including the Global War on Terrorism 17 Expeditionary Medal; while based with his squadron at Stewart Air 18 National Guard Base in Orange County, in New York, he demonstrated 19 pride in his Texas roots by maintaining a wardrobe full of Dallas 20 21 Cowboys jerseys, cowboy boots, cowboy hats, and Texas flag button-down shirts; and 22

23 WHEREAS, In his spare time, Josh Snowden enjoyed grilling 24 steaks, working on his truck, and listening to Texas country music,

1 preferably all at the same time; over the years, he brightened the 2 days of everyone he encountered with his irresistible smile, joyous 3 sense of humor, and wonderful gift for storytelling; this 4 great-hearted young man was sustained by a strong religious faith, 5 and he was a valued member of the Church of the Incarnation; and

6 WHEREAS, Josh Snowden was deeply devoted to his friends and 7 his family, whose members included, in addition to his mother and 8 his father, his "second father," Rick Hayslett, his sister, Sara, 9 his brothers, Drew, Tyler, Greg, and Bryan, and an older brother, 10 Eric, who predeceased him; and

WHEREAS, Serving with honor, courage, and dedication, Josh 11 Snowden embodied the highest ideals of the United States armed 12 forces, and he will be forever cherished by those who were 13 14 privileged to share in his love and affection; now, therefore, be it 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory 16 17 of Staff Sergeant Joshua Michael Snowden and extend sincere condolences to his loved ones and to all those who mourn his 18 19 passing; and, be it further

20 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 21 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of 22 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of U.S. Marine 23 Corps Staff Sergeant Joshua Michael Snowden.
