13 committee, and in 2011 he was recognized by the Republican Party of

15 gave of his time and talents by repairing old computers, which he
16 donated to nonprofit organizations; and

18 Sumerford and the proud father of two sons, Christopher and Jim, and
19 four daughters, Dawn, Sherry, Tricia, and Sheryl; he also
20 experienced the joy of welcoming 11 grandchildren and 10
