20 WHEREAS, In 1994, Mr. Hince joined the American Legion as a 21 member of Post 364 in Woodbridge, Virginia; after retiring to Bryan 22 in 2005, he joined Earl Graham Post 159, where he has served as 23 chaplain, adjutant, and first vice commander and twice as 24 commander; from 2012 to 2014, he was 6th District commander, and
