1 WHEREAS, Bailey Franklin of Boy Scouts of America Troop
2 No. 155 in Georgetown has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, The Eagle Scout badge is a significant honor
5 bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the scouting
6 movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding criteria,
7 Mr. Franklin earned 33 merit badges, and he successfully completed

20 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Franklin's dedication to excellence and
21 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy
22 to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with
23 pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
