1 WHEREAS, Tela Terry was crowned Miss Juneteenth-Baytown at
2 the 2017 Miss Juneteenth Baytown Pageant, held on June 9 at the
3 J. D. Walker Community Center; and

4 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the Rho Omicron Omega chapter of Alpha
5 Kappa Alpha Sorority, the pageant is part of Baytown's annual
6 Juneteenth festival, which commemorates the official end of slavery
7 in Texas; and

8 WHEREAS, On June 19, 1865, in Galveston, Major General Gordon
9 Granger issued an order in accordance with the Emancipation

13 layered with meaning, these Juneteenth observances pay tribute to
14 all those who endured the rigors of slavery, honor their
