RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, American popular music has lost one of its greatest
- 2 stars with the death of guitarist and singer Glen Campbell on August
- 3 8, 2017, at the age of 81; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Glen Travis Campbell was born in Billstown,
- 5 Arkansas, on April 22, 1936, to John and Carrie Campbell; one of 12
- 6 children in a family of sharecroppers, he learned to play the guitar
- 7 at the age of four, and he was playing professionally by the age of
- 8 15; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Early in his career, Mr. Campbell was a sought-after
- 10 session guitarist in Los Angeles, playing for artists as diverse as
- 11 Dean Martin, the Beach Boys, Merle Haggard, and the Ronettes, and
- 12 his guitar can be heard on such classic recordings as Frank
- 13 Sinatra's "Strangers in the Night," the Monkees' "I'm a Believer,"
- 14 and Elvis Presley's "Viva Las Vegas"; and
- WHEREAS, By the late 1960s, Mr. Campbell's country charm,
- 16 boyish good looks, and warm tenor voice had propelled him to stardom
- 17 in his own right, performing such hits as "Gentle on My Mind,"
- 18 "Wichita Lineman," "Galveston," and "By the Time I Get to Phoenix,"
- 19 and from 1969 to 1972, he hosted a hit TV variety show, $The\ Glen$
- 20 Campbell Goodtime Hour; during these years, he also appeared as a
- 21 Texas Ranger in the classic John Wayne western, True Grit, and as a
- 22 Vietnam veteran turned singer in the film Norwood; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Mr. Campbell went on to record more hits such as
- 24 "Rhinestone Cowboy," "Southern Nights," "Sunflower," and "Country

- 1 Boy"; over the course of a remarkable career that spanned half a
- 2 century, he recorded more than 70 albums and sold 45 million
- 3 records, including 12 gold records, 4 platinum records, and 1
- 4 double-platinum record; he won 10 Grammys, including 3 Grammy Hall
- 5 of Fame Awards and a Lifetime Achievement Award, and 10 Academy of
- 6 Country Music Awards; in 2005, he was inducted into the Country
- 7 Music Hall of Fame; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Near the end of his life, Mr. Campbell waged a
- 9 courageous public battle with Alzheimer's disease, undertaking a
- 10 "Goodbye Tour" during which he performed with members of his family
- 11 before sold-out crowds; he won his final Grammy for the last song he
- 12 ever recorded, "I'm Not Gonna Miss You," which was also featured in
- 13 the 2014 documentary, Glen Campbell: I'll Be Me; and
- WHEREAS, From the cotton fields of Arkansas to the recording
- 15 studios of Los Angeles to concert halls all around the world, Glen
- 16 Campbell won the respect of his peers and inspired generations of
- 17 younger performers with his musicianship and his talent, and the
- 18 mellow sound of his voice and the warmth of his personality will
- 19 remain forever gentle on the minds of his millions of fans; now,
- 20 therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 22 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory
- 23 of Glen Campbell and extend heartfelt sympathy to the members of his
- 24 family: to his wife, Kim Campbell; to his children, Debby, Kelli,
- 25 Travis, Kane, Dillon, Cal, Shannon, and Ashley; to his 10
- 26 grandchildren; and to his other relatives and his many friends and
