## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the small-sized district adjustment under the 3 Foundation School Program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 42.103(b) and (d), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (b) The basic allotment of a school district that [contains 8 at least 300 square miles and] has not more than 1,600 students in
- 9 average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:
- 10  $AA = (1 + ((1,600 ADA) \times .0004)) \times ABA$
- 11 (d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a
- 12 kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000
- 13 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the
- 14 formula, of the following formulas, that results in the greatest
- 15 adjusted allotment:
- 16 (1) the formula in Subsection (b), if  $[\frac{\text{or}}{\text{(c)}}]$  for
- 17 which] the district is eligible for that formula; or
- 18 (2)  $AA = (1 + ((5,000 ADA) \times .000025)) \times ABA.$
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 42.103(c), Education Code, is repealed.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017, if this
- 21 Act receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 22 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 23 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 24 date, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
