A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to pregnancy-related deaths and maternal morbidity,
3	including postpartum depression.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 34.005, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 34.005. DUTIES OF TASK FORCE. The task force shall:
8	(1) study and review:
9	(A) cases of pregnancy-related deaths; [and]
10	(B) trends <u>,</u> rates, or disparities in
11	<pre>pregnancy-related deaths and [in] severe maternal morbidity;</pre>
12	(C) health conditions and factors that
13	disproportionately affect the most at-risk population as
14	determined in the Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Task Force and
15	Department of State Health Services Joint Biennial Report (July
16	2016); and
17	(D) best practices and programs operating in
18	other states that have reduced rates of pregnancy-related deaths;
19	(2) compare rates of pregnancy-related deaths based on
20	the socioeconomic status of the mother;
21	(3) determine the feasibility of the task force
22	studying cases of severe maternal morbidity; and
23	(4) [(3)] make recommendations to help reduce the
24	incidence of pregnancy-related deaths and severe maternal

- 1 morbidity in this state.
- 2 SECTION 2. Sections 34.007(a) and (b), Health and Safety
- 3 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a) The department shall determine a statistically
- 5 significant number of cases of pregnancy-related deaths for review.
- 6 The department shall <u>either</u> randomly select cases <u>or select all</u>
- 7 <u>cases</u> for the task force to review under this subsection to reflect
- 8 a cross-section of pregnancy-related deaths in this state.
- 9 (b) The department shall statistically analyze aggregate
- 10 data of <u>pregnancy-related deaths and</u> severe maternal morbidity in
- 11 this state to identify any trends, rates, or disparities.
- 12 SECTION 3. Chapter 34, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
- 13 adding Section 34.0155 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 34.0155. REPORT ON PREGNANCY-RELATED DEATHS AND
- 15 POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION. The commission shall:
- 16 (1) evaluate options for reducing pregnancy-related
- 17 deaths, focusing on the most prevalent causes of pregnancy-related
- 18 deaths as identified in the task force's biennial report required
- 19 under Section 34.015, and for treating postpartum depression in
- 20 economically disadvantaged women; and
- 21 (2) submit a written report summarizing the
- 22 commission's and department's efforts to accomplish the tasks
- 23 described by Subdivision (1) to the governor, the lieutenant
- 24 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, the
- 25 Legislative Budget Board, and the appropriate standing committees
- 26 of the legislature not later than December 1 of each even-numbered
- 27 year.

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- 1 SECTION 4. Section 34.018, Health and Safety Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 34.018. SUNSET PROVISION. The task force is subject to
- 4 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued
- 5 in existence as provided by that chapter, the task force is
- 6 abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 2023 [2019].
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 12 legislative session.
