A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to election of professional staff representatives to
- 3 certain school district planning and decision-making committees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.251, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (e) The board shall adopt a procedure, consistent with
- 9 Subsection (e-1) and Section 21.407(a), for the professional staff
- 10 in the district to nominate and elect the professional staff
- 11 representatives who shall meet with the board or the board designee
- 12 as required under this section. At least two-thirds of the elected
- 13 professional staff representatives must be classroom
- 14 teachers. The remaining staff representatives shall include both
- 15 campus- and district-level professional staff members. If
- 16 practicable, the committee membership shall include at least one
- 17 professional staff representative with the primary responsibility
- 18 for educating students with disabilities. Board policy must
- 19 provide procedures for:
- 20 (1) the selection of parents to the district-level and
- 21 campus-level committees; and
- 22 (2) the selection of community members and business
- 23 representatives to serve on the district-level committee in a
- 24 manner that provides for appropriate representation of the

- 1 community's diversity.
- 2 (e-1) The procedure for the election of professional staff
- 3 representatives to a campus-level or district-level committee
- 4 under Subsection (e):
- 5 (1) must provide for appropriate and inclusive
- 6 representation of the district's professional staff; and
- 7 (2) may not limit eligibility for election to members
- 8 of a single professional association or organization.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 10 school year.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 16 legislative session.
