## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to the disclosure of records produced in the course of an 2 3 investigation related to educator misconduct. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is 5 6 amended by adding Section 21.063 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 21.063. INVESTIGATION RECORDS. (a) A record produced 8 by the board in the course of an investigation involving an alleged incident of educator misconduct, if the record is involving a 9 10 complaint determined to be groundless, is confidential and not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code. 11 12 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) and except as otherwise provided by a court order prohibiting disclosure, a record produced 13 by the board in the course of an investigation involving an alleged 14 incident of educator misconduct may be used in a disciplinary 15 proceeding against a teacher or administrator based on a report 16 17 submitted under Section 21.006 concerning an alleged incident of misconduct, if permissible under rules of evidence applicable to a 18 contested case, as provided by Section 2001.081, Government Code. 19 The record remains confidential and not subject to disclosure under 20 Chapter 552, Government Code, unless it becomes a part of the record 21 in a contested case under Chapter 2001, Government Code. 22 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
