## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to pregnancy-related deaths and maternal morbidity and the creation of a maternal health care quality improvement program. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 34, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 34.0155 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 34.0155. MATERNAL HEALTH CARE QUALITY IMPROVEMENT 7 PROGRAM. (a) The commission, department, and task force shall 8 9 implement a program to distribute maternal safety informational materials to health care providers in this state to improve the 10 health care response for leading causes of preventable death among 11 pregnant and postpartum women. 12 (b) The commission, department, and task force shall 13 14 develop maternal safety informational materials that include tools and procedures based on best practices for common medical issues in 15 maternal health. The informational materials must include for each 16 maternal health issue: 17 18 (1) care guidelines accessible in multiple formats, including paper and electronic; 19 (2) a guide for implementing best practices in care 20 21 provided by hospitals; and (3) a <u>slide set for professional education focused on</u> 22 23 maternal health care. 24 (c) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year,

the commission shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant 1 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, the 2 Legislative Budget Board, and the appropriate standing committees 3 of the legislature a written report that includes: 4 (1) a summary of the program's implementation and 5 6 outcomes; and 7 (2) a summary on the feasibility of adding a provider's use of procedures included in the maternal safety informational 8 9 materials as an indicator of quality for commission data. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13

Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
