- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. The following riders to S.B. 1, Acts of the 85th
- 9 Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 (the General Appropriations
- 10 Act), are repealed:
- 11 (1) Rider 6 following the appropriations to the Texas
- 12 Medical Board (page VIII-35); and
- 13 (2) Rider 2 following the appropriations to the Texas
- 14 State Board of Examiners of Psychologists (page VIII-51).
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 20 legislative session.
