A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to bonuses for public school classroom teachers and state
- 3 assistance for the Texas Public School Employees Group Insurance
- 4 Program; making an appropriation.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) The amount of \$193 million of the
- 7 unencumbered appropriations from the general revenue fund for the
- 8 state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2019, made by Chapter 605
- 9 (S.B. 1), Acts of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 (the
- 10 General Appropriations Act), to the Health and Human Services
- 11 Commission is transferred to the Texas Education Agency to be used
- 12 by the agency to provide the following bonuses to public school
- 13 classroom teachers:
- 14 (1) a bonus of \$600 to be paid in September 2018 for
- 15 each classroom teacher with at least 6 but less than 11 years of
- 16 teaching experience at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year;
- 17 and
- 18 (2) a bonus of \$1,000 to be paid in September 2018 for
- 19 each classroom teacher with at least 11 years of teaching
- 20 experience at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year.
- 21 (b) The Health and Human Services Commission shall identify
- 22 the strategies and objectives out of which the transfer under
- 23 Subsection (a) of this section is to be made.
- (c) A bonus provided to a public school classroom teacher in

- 1 accordance with Subsection (a) of this section is not considered in
- 2 determining whether a school district is paying the teacher the
- 3 minimum monthly salary under Section 21.402, Education Code.
- 4 (d) The Texas Education Agency shall provide a bonus under
- 5 this section only to a person employed as a public school classroom
- 6 teacher at the time the bonus is paid.
- 7 SECTION 2. (a) The amount of \$212.7 million is appropriated
- 8 from the economic stabilization fund to the Teacher Retirement
- 9 System of Texas for use as provided by this section.
- 10 (b) The amount of \$212 million of the unencumbered
- 11 appropriations from the general revenue fund for the state fiscal
- 12 biennium ending August 31, 2019, made by Chapter 605 (S.B. 1), Acts
- 13 of the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017 (the General
- 14 Appropriations Act), to the Health and Human Services Commission is
- 15 transferred to the Teacher Retirement System of Texas for use as
- 16 provided by this section.
- 17 (c) The Health and Human Services Commission shall identify
- 18 the strategies and objectives out of which the transfer under
- 19 Subsection (b) of this section is to be made.
- 20 (d) The Teacher Retirement System of Texas may use the money
- 21 appropriated under Subsection (a) of this section and transferred
- 22 under Subsection (b) of this section to:
- 23 (1) reduce costs, including premiums, deductibles,
- 24 and prescription drug copayments, for participants in the Texas
- 25 Public School Employees Group Insurance Program authorized by
- 26 Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, during the 2018 and 2019 plan years;
- 27 and

- 1 (2) reduce the premium and maximum out-of-pocket cost
- 2 for an enrolled adult child with a mental disability or a physical
- 3 incapacity during the 2018 and 2019 plan years.
- 4 (e) The Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall determine
- 5 the most efficient allocation of the money appropriated under
- 6 Subsection (a) of this section and transferred under Subsection (b)
- 7 of this section to achieve the maximum benefit for participants in
- 8 the program.
- 9 SECTION 3. (a) Subject to Subsection (b) of this section:
- 10 (1) this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a
- 11 vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; and
- 13 (2) if this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 14 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 15 last day of the legislative session.
- 16 (b) This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote of
- 17 two-thirds of the members present in each house of the legislature,
- 18 as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas Constitution.
