1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 2 proposing a constitutional amendment to dedicate the net revenue
- 3 from the state lottery to the foundation school fund, including a
- 4 portion dedicated to funding salary increases and bonuses for

- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 9 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 10 (f) Beginning with the state fiscal year that begins
- 11 <u>September 1, 2019, revenue received by the State in each state</u>
- 12 fiscal year from the operation of lotteries, after the payment of
- 13 administrative costs, amounts paid for lottery prizes, and any net
- 14 proceeds paid for veterans' assistance attributable to a lottery
- 15 game established by law to fund veterans' assistance, shall be
- 16 deposited in the foundation school fund established by law. Fifty
- 17 percent of the funds desposited in the foundation school fund from
- 18 the operation of lotteries may be used only to fund salary increases
- 19 and bonuses for public school classroom teachers with at least six
- 20 years of teaching experience and for the school district teacher
- 21 retirement contribution costs exclusively associated with salary
- 22 adjustments authorized by this provision.
- 23 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 24 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.

- 1 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 2 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to dedicate the net
- 3 revenue from the state lottery to the foundation school fund, and to
- 4 dedicate 50 percent of that net revenue to funding salary increases
- 5 and bonuses for experienced public school classroom teachers and
- 6 school district costs associated with teacher retirement
- 7 contributions authorized by this provision."
