## In Memory of Moises Vicente Vela Sr.

Vela Middle School opened and was named in his honor as a tribute to his exemplary public service; and

WHEREAS, Moises shared more than 60 years of marriage with Mary Jo Vela, and they guided their five children by loving example; he was a beloved patriarch who found immense joy in his role as "Pipo" to his many adoring grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and
