WHEREAS, Trooper Randolph is a highly respected officer who has diligently upheld the department's mission to protect and serve the citizens of Texas; he has manifested uncommon dedication in managing his far-reaching responsibilities, and he is admired by colleagues and area residents for his bravery and perseverance; and

WHEREAS, The Texas Department of Public Safety and the Texas Public Safety Commission honored Trooper Randolph for his exceptional act of heroism with a Lifesaving Award at a ceremony in Austin on June 15, 2017; now, therefore, be it
