Relating to the issuance of a permit by a political subdivision.

SB 14 **Hall**

Relating to a property owner's right to remove a tree or vegetation.

Relating to prosecution of certain offenses involving and preemption of local regulation of the use of a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle.

SB 17 **Kolkhorst/ Huffman/ Nelson**

Relating to maternal health and safety, pregnancy-related deaths, and maternal morbidity, including postpartum depression.

SB 20 **Taylor, Van**

Relating to the continuation and sunset review of certain governmental entities subject to abolishment on September 1, 2017.

SB 21 **Nelson**

Relating to the system for protesting or appealing certain ad valorem tax determinations; authorizing a fee.

SB 22 **Hall**

Relating to the small-sized district adjustment under the Foundation School Program.

SB 23 **Hall**

Relating to prohibition of certain regulations by a county, municipality, or other political subdivision.

SB 24 **Hall**

Relating to protection of energy critical infrastructure.

SB 25 **Hall**

Relating to distracted driving; creating a criminal offense.

SB 26 **Miles**

Relating to the use of certain controlled substances by women who are pregnant or may become pregnant and the designation of neonatal abstinence syndrome from substance use as a reportable condition.

Relating to the automatic enrollment of certain women in the Texas women's health program.

Relating to certain governmental entities subject to the sunset review process.

Relating to a reporting requirement for certain incidents of sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence, or stalking at certain public and private institutions of higher education; creating a criminal offense; authorizing administrative penalties.

SB 30 **Menéndez**

Relating to the salary paid to classroom teachers employed by public schools; making an appropriation.

SB 31 **Menéndez**

Relating to requiring the board of trustees of each school district to create a nonvoting parent trustee position on the board.

SB 32 **Menéndez**

Relating to the salary paid to classroom teachers employed by public schools.

SB 33 **Menéndez/ Rodríguez**

Relating to a school district assigning a mentor teacher to a new classroom teacher.

Relating to an opportunity to correct a defect in an early voting ballot voted by mail and to the use of an application for an early voting ballot to change a voter's registration address within the county.

SB 51 **Buckingham**

Relating to election of professional staff representatives to certain school district planning and decision-making committees.

SB 52 **Huffines**

Relating to a supermajority requirement for an election authorizing the issuance of bonds issued by a political subdivision.

SB 53 **Huffines**

Relating to the participation of a charitable organization that facilitates the procurement of an elective abortion in the state employee charitable campaign.

SB 54 **Huffines**

Relating to the award of court costs and attorney's fees in certain actions challenging an order, ordinance, or similar measure of certain political subdivisions or the failure of an officer of certain political subdivisions to perform certain actions.

SB 55 **Huffines**

Relating to procedures for certain municipalities to adopt or amend a national model building code.
