1 Amend H.R. No. 3 (Adopting the Housekeeping Resolution for  
2 the House of Representatives of the 85th Legislature) by adding  
3 the following appropriately numbered SECTION to Article 3 of the  
4 resolution and renumbering the remaining SECTIONS of Article 3  
5 accordingly:

6 SECTION 3. . BIOLOGICAL SEX DESIGNATION FOR CERTAIN  
7 MULTIPLE-OCCUPANCY FACILITIES. (a) In view of every person's  
8 fundamental interest in privacy while in a state of undress, the  
9 house of representatives shall continue to designate any  
10 multiple-occupancy facility under the jurisdiction of the house  
11 to be used only by a person based on the person's biological  
12 sex.

13 (b) In this section:

14 (1) "Biological sex" means the physical condition of  
15 being male or female, which is stated on a person's birth  
16 certificate.

17 (2) "Multiple-occupancy facility" means showers,  
18 changing rooms, and bathrooms designed or designated for use by  
19 more than one person at a time, where a person may be in a state  
20 of undress in the presence of another person, regardless of  
21 whether or not the facility provides curtains or partial walls  
22 for privacy.

23 (c) This section does not prohibit the house of  
24 representatives from providing an accommodation, including the  
25 use of a single-occupancy facility. The house may not provide an  
26 accommodation that allows a person to use a multiple-occupancy  
27 facility accessible to a person that is designated for the  
28 biological sex opposite to the person's biological sex.

29 (d) This section does not apply to a person entering a  
30 multiple-occupancy facility designated for the biological sex

1 opposite to the person's biological sex:

2 (1) for cleaning or maintenance;

3 (2) to accompany a person needing assistance;

4 (3) if the person is a parent or other person  
5 assisting a child; or

6 (4) if the multiple-occupancy facility is temporarily  
7 designated for use by that person's biological sex.

8 (e) The Committee on House Administration shall adopt  
9 policies as necessary to implement this section.
