

Amend CSHB 3593 (house committee report) as follows:

(1) On page 1, line 9, strike "Subsections (a), (f), and (g-2)" and substitute "Subsections (f) and (g-2)".

(2) Strike page 1, line 11, through page 2, line 8.

(3) On page 3, strike lines 3 and 4 and substitute the following:

SECTION 2. Section 28.025, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b-12) and (c-1) and adding Subsection (c-10) to read as follows:

(4) Strike page 3, line 11, through page 4, line 3.

(5) On page 5, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

(c-10) In adopting rules under Subsection (c-1), the State Board of Education shall adopt or select five technology applications courses on cybersecurity to be included in a cybersecurity pathway for the science, technology, engineering, and mathematics endorsement.

(6) Strike SECTION 3 of the bill (page 5, lines 13 through 19).

(7) Strike SECTION 5 of the bill (page 6, lines 8 through 18).

(8) Strike SECTIONS 8 and 9 of the bill (page 11, line 3, through page 14, line 8).

(9) Strike SECTION 11 of the bill (page 14, lines 15 through 20).

(10) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill:

SECTION \_\_\_\_ . Section 42.154(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) In this section:

(1) "Career and technology education class" and "career and technology education program" include a technology applications course on cybersecurity adopted or selected by the State Board of Education under Section 28.025(c-10).

(2) "Full-time [~~,"full-time~~ equivalent student" means 30 hours of contact a week between a student and career and technology education program personnel.

(11) Renumber remaining SECTIONS of the bill accordingly.
