Amend CSSB 1 (house committee report) as follows:

- (1) In Section 17.13, Article IX of the bill (page IX-84), strike the text for the Department of Information Resources and reduce the appropriation from the Economic Stabilization Fund to the department in the amount of \$50,000,000 for the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2017.
- (2) In Article IX of the bill, add the following appropriately numbered rider and renumber subsequent riders accordingly:

IX._____. Statewide Information Technology and Cybersecurity Initiatives. (a) Appropriations to state agencies made in other provisions of this Act are increased in the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2017, by \$46,849,489 out of Economic Stabilization Funds, by \$2,050,000 out of State Highway Fund 006, and by \$400,000 out of the Texas Department of Motor Vehicle Fund for the purpose of implementing information technology and cybersecurity initiatives.

(b) In addition to appropriations made elsewhere in this Act, appropriations described by Subsection (a) of this section are allocated as provided below and appropriations for the "Number of Full-Time-Equivalents (FTE)" are increased for agencies listed below for the sole purpose of the implementation of the initiatives described by Subsection (a) of this section:

_____. UT Center for Identity. In addition to other amounts appropriated to The University of Texas at Austin under this Act, the amount of \$2,000,000 is appropriated out of the Economic Stabilization Fund to The University of Texas at Austin for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2019, to the university's Center for Identity IDWise program to provide research-based tools, educational materials, workshops, and outreach to help members of the public protect their identities and combat identity theft, fraud, and abuse.
