FLOOR AMENDMENT NO.\_\_\_\_\_

Amend C.S.S.B. No. 11 (house committee report) by adding the 1 following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and 2 renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Subchapter B, Chapter 264, Family Code, is 4 amended by adding Section 264.1252 to read as follows: 5 Sec. 264.1252. REIMBURSEMENT FOR ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES; 6 CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) In this section, "enrichment activities" 7 includes athletic camps and competition, art and music classes and 8 camps, school-related extracurricular activities, faith-based 9 camps or mission trips, and the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl 10 Scouts of the United States of America, or similar organizations 11 and activities. The term does not include entertainment activities 12 that a child participates in solely with the child's foster parent. 13 (b) At the foster parent's discretion, the foster parent may 14 enroll a foster child in age-appropriate enrichment activities. 15 (c) The department shall reimburse a foster parent for 16 monetary expenses relating to the participation of a child in 17 enrichment activities not to exceed \$200 per month for each child. 18 The foster parent must provide the department with receipts for 19 expenses under this subsection to receive reimbursement. 20 (d) A person commits an offense if, with intent to defraud 21 or deceive the department, the person knowingly makes or causes to 22 be made a false statement or misrepresentation of a material fact 23 that allows a person to receive a reimbursement under Subsection 24 (c). An offense under this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor. 25
