- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 11 (house committee printing) as follows:
- 2 (1) On page 13, lines 18 and 19, strike "is examined and
- 3 receives a mental health screening conducted by" and substitute
- 4 "receives an initial medical examination and a mental health
- 5 screening from".
- 6 (2) On page 13, following line 27, insert the following:
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the department shall
- 8 ensure that any child that enters the conservatorship of the
 - department receives any necessary emergency medical care as soon as
- 10 possible.
- 11 (d) A physician or other health care provider conducting an
- 12 examination under Subsection (b) may not administer a vaccination
- 13 as part of the examination, except that a physician or other health
- 14 care provider may administer a tetanus vaccination to a child in a
- 15 commercially available preparation if the physician or other health
- 16 care provider determines that an emergency circumstance requires
- 17 the administration of the vaccination. The prohibition on the
- 18 administration of a vaccination under this subsection does not
- 19 apply after the department has been named managing conservator of
- 20 the child after a hearing under Section 262.106 or 262.201.
- 21 (3) On page 14, line 1, strike "(c)" and substitute "(e)".
- 22 (4) On page 14, line 5, strike "(d)" and substitute "(f)".
- 23 (5) On page 14, line 6, strike "relevant medical
- 24 practitioners" and substitute "selected physicians and other
- 25 health care providers authorized under state law to conduct medical
- 26 examinations".
- 27 (6) On page 14, line 9, following "screening.", insert the
- 28 following:
- 29 The guidelines developed under this subsection must provide

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assistance and guidance regarding:
              (1) assessing a child for:
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                   (A) signs and symptoms of child abuse and
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   neglect;
                   (B) the presence of acute or chronic illness; and
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                   (C) signs of acute or severe mental health
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   conditions;
              (2) monitoring the adjustment of a child to the
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   conservatorship of the department;
              (3) ensuring a child has necessary medical equipment
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   and any medication prescribed to the child or needed by the child;
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   and
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              (4) providing appropriate support and education to a
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   child's caregivers.
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         (7) On page 14, between lines 9 and 10, insert the
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16 following:
         (g) Notwithstanding any other law, the guidelines developed
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18 under Subsection (f) do not create a standard of care for a
19 physician or other health care provider authorized under state law
20 to conduct medical examinations, and a physician or other health
    care provider may not be subject to criminal, civil, or
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22 administrative penalty or civil liability for failure to adhere to
23 the guidelines.
          (8) On page 14, line 10, strike "(e)" and substitute "(h)".
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
