| 4  | SECTION Subchapter H, Chapter 81, Government Code, is               |
| 5  | amended by adding Section 81.116 to read as follows:                |
| 6  | Sec. 81.116. CLAIM OR DEFENSE FOR PROHIBITED RULE OR                |
| 7  | POLICY. (a) A person may assert as an affirmative defense in an     |
| 8  | administrative hearing or as a claim or defense in a judicial       |
| 9  | proceeding under Chapter 37, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, that |
| 10 | a state bar rule or policy or a penalty imposed by the board of     |
| 11 | directors:  |
| 12 | (1) limits the ability of an applicant to be licensed               |
| 13 | based on a sincerely held religious belief of the applicant; or     |
| 14 | (2) burdens a license holder's:                                     |
| 15 | (A) free exercise of religion, regardless of                        |
| 16 | whether the burden is the result of a rule generally applicable to  |
| 17 | all license holders;  |
| 18 | (B) freedom of speech regarding a sincerely held                    |
| 19 | religious belief; or  |
| 20 | (C) membership in any religious organization.                       |
| 21 | (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a state bar rule or            |
| 22 | policy or a penalty imposed by the board of directors that results  |
| 23 | in a limitation or burden described by Subsection (a) if the rule,  |
| 24 | policy, or penalty is:  |
| 25 | (1) in furtherance of a compelling governmental                     |
| 26 | purpose; and  |

| 28 | (c) A person may bring an action for injunctive relief              |
| 29 | against a violation of this section.                                |
