AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT

Interested parties report that the board of regents of The Texas A&M University System would like to bring a new campus in Brazos County into the university system. H.B. 2432 seeks to provide for the establishment of a university system center in Brazos County as part of The Texas A&M University System.

H.B. 2432 amends current law relating to the establishment of a university system center located in Brazos County as part of The Texas A&M University System.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Amends Chapter 87, Education Code, by adding Subchapter M, as follows:

SUBCHAPTER M. UNIVERSITY SYSTEM CENTERS

Sec. 87.881. UNIVERSITY SYSTEM CENTER IN BRAZOS COUNTY. (a) Authorizes the board of regents of the Texas A&M University System (board of regents) to establish and operate a university system center in Brazos County.

- (b) Requires that the programs offered at the university system center be authorized in accordance with the rules of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.
- (c) Provides that the board of regents has the sole authority to name the university system center authorized by this section.

SECTION 2. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2017.
