A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain lottery prize winners' choice to remain
- 3 anonymous.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 466.015, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) The commission shall adopt rules governing
- 8 nondisclosure of the personally identifiable information of
- 9 <u>certain lottery prize winners under Section 466.411.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 466.022(b), Government Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (b) In addition to commission records excepted from
- 13 disclosure under Chapter 552, the following information is
- 14 confidential and is exempt from disclosure:
- 15 (1) security plans and procedures of the commission
- 16 designed to ensure the integrity and security of the operation of
- 17 the lottery;
- 18 (2) information of a nature that is designed to ensure
- 19 the integrity and security of the selection of winning tickets or
- 20 numbers in the lottery, other than information describing the
- 21 general procedures for selecting winning tickets or numbers; [and]
- 22 (3) the street address and telephone number of a prize
- 23 winner, if the prize winner has not consented to the release of the
- 24 information; and

- 1 (4) except as otherwise authorized by Section 466.411,
- 2 all personally identifiable information of a natural person who is:
- 3 (A) a lottery prize winner and who has chosen to
- 4 remain anonymous under Section 466.411; or
- 5 (B) an owner of a beneficial interest in a legal
- 6 entity that is a lottery prize winner and who has chosen to remain
- 7 <u>anonymous under Section 466.411</u>.
- 8 SECTION 3. Subchapter I, Chapter 466, Government Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 466.411 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 466.411. CHOICE BY CERTAIN PRIZE WINNERS TO REMAIN
- 11 ANONYMOUS. (a) Subject to Subsection (b), a natural person who is
- 12 a prize winner of a lottery prize in an amount equal to \$1 million or
- 13 more, or who is an owner of a beneficial interest in a legal entity
- 14 that is a prize winner of a lottery prize in an amount equal to \$1
- 15 million or more, may on the date the winner claims the prize choose
- 16 to remain anonymous and prohibit all personally identifiable
- 17 information from being released to the public.
- 18 (b) The commission may release or disclose the personally
- 19 identifiable information of a natural person who is a lottery prize
- 20 winner if the person chooses to have the prize paid in periodic
- 21 installments. The commission may only disclose the information on
- 22 or after the 30th day after the date the person claims the lottery
- 23 prize if the person chooses to remain anonymous under Subsection
- 24 (a).
- 25 (c) For purposes of this section, the amount of a lottery
- 26 prize is the total amount of prize money paid to a prize winner for a
- 27 single lottery prize claim, whether paid in one payment or in

- 1 periodic installments, before deducting any federal tax
- 2 withholdings or other deductions required by law.
- 3 (d) This section does not prohibit release of a natural
- 4 person prize winner's city or county of residence or prevent the
- 5 commission from releasing the person's personally identifiable
- 6 information to the Health and Human Services Commission or as
- 7 necessary to comply with Section 466.407 or 466.4075.
- 8 SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2017, the Texas
- 9 Lottery Commission shall adopt the rules and procedures necessary
- 10 to implement the changes in law made by this Act to Chapter 466,
- 11 Government Code.
- 12 (b) Section 466.411, Government Code, as added by this Act,
- 13 applies only to an initial claim for a lottery prize in an amount
- 14 equal to \$1 million or more that is submitted to the Texas Lottery
- 15 Commission on or after January 1, 2018.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
