A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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| 2 | relating to the transportation of certain mental health patients. |
| 3 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 4 | SECTION 1. Section 573.012, Health and Safety Code, is |
| 5 | amended by adding Subsections (j) and (k) to read as follows: |
| 6 | (j) In a county located on the Texas-Mexico border that has |
| 7 | a population of 500,000 or more and is adjacent to two or more |
| 8 | counties each of which has a population of 50,000 or more, the judge |
| 9 | or magistrate may authorize, in the following order of priority, |
| 10 | the transportation of a person apprehended under this section to |
| 11 | the appropriate mental health facility by: |
| 12 | (1) a relative or other responsible person who has a |
| 13 | proper interest in the person's welfare and who receives no |
| 14 | remuneration, except for actual and necessary expenses; |
| 15 | (2) the facility administrator of the appropriate |
| 16 | mental health facility, unless the administrator notifies the judge |
| 17 | or magistrate that facility personnel are not available to |
| 18 | transport the patient; |
| 19 | (3) a representative of the local mental health |
| 20 | authority, who shall be reimbursed by the county; |
| 21 | (4) a special officer for mental health assignment |
| 22 | certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code, who shall be |
| 23 | reimbursed by the Department of State Health Services from money |
| 24 | appropriated for that purpose, or if money is not appropriated for |

- 1 that purpose, as provided by Section 571.018; or
- 2 (5) the sheriff, a constable, or any on-duty peace
- 3 officer if no person is available under Subdivision (1), (2), (3),
- 4 or (4), who shall be reimbursed by the Department of State Health
- 5 Services from money appropriated for that purpose, or if money is
- 6 not appropriated for that purpose, as provided by Section 571.018.
- 7 (k) A person who under Subsection (j) is authorized by the
- 8 court to transport a person to a mental health facility may contract
- 9 with a person that is listed as a qualified transportation service
- 10 provider by the commissioners court of the county in which the court
- 11 is located to provide the transportation authorized by the court.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 573, Health and Safety
- 13 Code, is amended by adding Section 573.013 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 573.013. LIST OF QUALIFIED TRANSPORTATION SERVICE
- 15 PROVIDERS. The commissioners court of a county located on the
- 16 Texas-Mexico border that has a population of 500,000 or more and is
- 17 adjacent to two or more counties each of which has a population of
- 18 50,000 or more by order shall:
- 19 (1) establish and maintain a list of qualified
- 20 transportation service providers with whom a person may contract in
- 21 accordance with Section 573.012;
- 22 (2) prescribe uniform standards that a person must
- 23 meet to be listed as a qualified transportation service provider;
- 24 (3) establish an application procedure for a person to
- 25 be included on the list, including an appropriate application fee
- 26 to be deposited in the county general fund;
- 27 (4) require officers and employees of the county to

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- 1 contract with persons on the list, on a rotating basis, when the
- 2 officer or employee is authorized to provide transportation under
- 3 Section 573.012(j)(5);
- 4 (5) ensure that the list is made available to any
- 5 person authorized to provide transportation under Section 573.012;
- 6 <u>and</u>
- 7 (6) establish a procedure for a person to be removed
- 8 from the list not later than 30 days after the date the
- 9 commissioners court receives notice that the person chooses to be
- 10 <u>removed.</u>
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
