- 19 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 531.0911, Government
- 20 Code, as added by this Act, the Health and Human Services Commission
- 21 is not required to issue electronic benefits transfer cards that
- 22 comply with that section until September 1, 2018, but is required to
- 23 begin issuing cards that comply with that section beginning on that
- 24 date. The commission shall ensure that on or before August 31, 2020,
