7	Sec. 215.001. MUNICIPAL REGULATION OF OCCUPATIONS IN
8	GENERAL. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Occupational license" means a license, permit,
10	registration certificate, or other evidence of authority that is:
11	(A) issued by a licensing authority; and
12	(B) required by an ordinance or a law for a person
13	to practice an occupation.
14	(2) "State licensing authority" means a state agency,
15	department, board, or commission or the executive or administrative
16	officer of a state agency, department, board, or commission that
17	issues an occupational license.
18	(b) Notwithstanding any other state law, including Section
19	51.001, unless expressly authorized by state law, the governing
20	body of a municipality may not adopt or enforce any ordinance, rule,
21	or regulation that:
22	(1) establishes additional, more stringent licensing
23	requirements for an occupation that requires an occupational
24	license issued by a state licensing authority; or

- 2 <u>license issued by the municipality.</u>
- 3 (c) A municipal ordinance, rule, or regulation that violates
- 4 this section is void and unenforceable.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
