4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 29.067 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 29.067. STUDY REGARDING COSTS OF EDUCATING STUDENTS OF
8	LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY; REPORT. (a) The agency shall conduct
9	a study to examine the costs of educating a student of limited
10	English proficiency in public schools. The study must:
11	(1) determine whether the bilingual education
12	allotment under Section 42.153 provides adequate funding to schools
13	for meeting the educational needs of students of limited English
14	<pre>proficiency;</pre>
15	(2) if it is determined under Subdivision (1) that the
16	bilingual education allotment is inadequate, determine the amount
17	of adjustment for the bilingual education allotment that would
18	provide adequate funding to schools for meeting the educational
19	needs of students of limited English proficiency;
20	(3) determine whether the educational needs of
21	students of limited English proficiency and the costs of meeting
22	those needs vary by grade level from kindergarten through the 12th
23	grade; and
24	(4) identify measures that may lower costs and improve

1	outcomes, including:
2	(A) implementation of:
3	(i) new technologies;
4	(ii) new teaching mediums; and
5	(iii) new teaching techniques; and
6	(B) changes to the duration of the academic
7	calendar and school day.
8	(b) Not later than January 1, 2018, the agency shall prepare
9	a report detailing the results of the study under this section and
10	submit the report to each standing legislative committee with
11	primary jurisdiction over primary and secondary education.
12	(c) This section expires September 1, 2018.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
17	Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
