A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to reporting principal turnover information in the
- 3 performance report of a public school district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 39.306(a) and (e), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Each board of trustees shall publish an annual report
- 8 describing the educational performance of the district and of each
- 9 campus in the district that includes uniform student performance
- 10 and descriptive information as determined under rules adopted by
- 11 the commissioner. The annual report must also include:
- 12 (1) campus performance objectives established under
- 13 Section 11.253 and the progress of each campus toward those
- 14 objectives, which shall be available to the public;
- 15 (2) information indicating the district's
- 16 accreditation status and identifying each district campus awarded a
- 17 distinction designation under Subchapter G or considered an
- 18 unacceptable campus under Subchapter E;
- 19 (3) the district's current special education
- 20 compliance status with the agency;
- 21 (4) a statement of the number, rate, and type of
- 22 violent or criminal incidents that occurred on each district
- 23 campus, to the extent permitted under the Family Educational Rights
- 24 and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g);

and

1 (5) information concerning school violence prevention and violence intervention policies and procedures that the district 2 3 is using to protect students; 4 (6) the findings that result from evaluations 5 conducted under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act of 1994 (20 U.S.C. Section 7101 et seq.); [and] 6 information received under Section 51.403(e) for 7 (7) 8 each high school campus in the district, presented in a form determined by the commissioner; and 9 10 (8) information concerning principal turnover, including the number of principals: 11 12 (A) newly employed as a principal in 13 district; 14 (B) transferred from one campus to another campus 15 in the district; 16 (C) remaining employed by the district in a 17 capacity other than as a principal; 18 (D) leaving the district for employment as a 19 principal in another school district; (E) leaving the district for employment in a 20 capacity other than as a principal in another school district; and 21 (F) leaving employment in public education. 22 23 The report may include the following information: 24 student information, including total enrollment,

enrollment by ethnicity, socioeconomic status, and grade groupings

(2) financial information, including revenues

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and retention rates:

- 1 expenditures;
- 2 (3) staff information <u>in addition to the information</u>
- 3 required under Subsection (a)(8), including number and type of
- 4 staff by sex, ethnicity, years of experience, and highest degree
- 5 held, teacher and administrator salaries, and teacher turnover;
- 6 (4) program information, including student enrollment
- 7 by program, teachers by program, and instructional operating
- 8 expenditures by program; and
- 9 (5) the number of students placed in a disciplinary
- 10 alternative education program under Chapter 37.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 12 school year.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
