H.B. No. 189

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the basic allotment under the foundation school
3 program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 42.101(a), Education Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (a) For each student in average daily attendance, not
8 including the time students spend each day in special education
9 programs in an instructional arrangement other than mainstream or
10 career and technology education programs, for which an additional
11 allotment is made under Subchapter C, a district is entitled to an
12 allotment equal to the lesser of \$5,140 [~~\$4,765~~] or the amount that
13 results from the following formula:

$$A = \underline{\$5,140} [\del{\$4,765}] \times (\text{DCR}/\text{MCR})$$

15 where:

16 "A" is the allotment to which a district is entitled;

17 "DCR" is the district's compressed tax rate, which is the
18 product of the state compression percentage, as determined under
19 Section 42.2516, multiplied by the maintenance and operations tax
20 rate adopted by the district for the 2005 tax year; and

21 "MCR" is the state maximum compressed tax rate, which is the
22 product of the state compression percentage, as determined under
23 Section 42.2516, multiplied by \$1.50.

24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
